



Barn Rules

Effective January 1, 2018

Barn Hours – 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Rings are scheduled to be dragged first thing in the morning. Please refrain from riding in rings during maintenance times.

Board and lesson payment checks should be placed in the small wooden locked mail box in the show office.

Unauthorized Areas

Only CVF employees are allowed in the hayloft, feed room, storage rooms, shavings shed and maintenance rooms.

If your horse requires special hay or grain please inform the Barn Manager that you are bringing it in and they will assist you on the storage of the feed.

If additional shavings are desired, please see CVF barn staff who will support you in obtaining additional shavings for a cost of \$5.00 a wheel barrel.

Aisle & Wash Racks

No riding or mounting a horse in the aisle, stalls or wash rack areas.

Clean up after your horse in the aisles and wash/grooming rack. There are brooms, shovels and manure buckets throughout the barn, please use them.

Riding Helmets

Everyone on Chagrin Valley Farms property (regardless of age or experience) must wear an approved riding helmet while mounted – no exceptions.

Appropriate Attire

You are advised to always wear hard-soled, fully enclosed shoes or boots and socks to protect feet and long pants to protect legs. Steel-toed safety shoes or boots are very beneficial in

preventing or minimizing injury should a horse step on your foot. Do not wear flip flops or sandals when handling a horse or while anywhere near a horse.

Arena Rules

Please check the lesson board and show schedule to determine ideal riding times. The trainers and CVF management are trying to keep this updated to alleviate unnecessary ring congestion. CVF Management reserves the right to limit the number of riders to a safe level.

No indoor turn outs.

Please pick-up your horse's manure in the indoor arenas.

No lunging in the front ring. No lunging during lessons.

A rider must be in a lesson to jump and under a trainer's supervision.

Be courteous. Be aware of the other people in the arena.

Visitors are not allowed in the riding arena except in designated viewing areas.

Feeding

Please do not touch or feed anyone else's horse unless you have received permission from the owner.

Please do not feed additional hay to your horse. If you need to adjust your feed portions see the Barn Manager.

Dogs

Dogs are to be leashed at all times and are not to be left unattended.

Dogs are not permitted in the arena.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in the barn areas and all places on the premises.

Facility Use

Shows, clinics, lessons and special events will be offered. These events will have precedence in the facility. CVF Management will keep you informed of these activities with as much advanced notice as possible.
