Job Requirements:

- Supervise and ensure the safety of campers
- Supervise children in every activity and during lunch
- Assist children with projects/crafts
- Supervise and participate in clean-up duties at the end of each day
- Aid instructors in teaching group lessons
- Ensure that school horses are prepped and clean for campers
- Set up classroom areas and workspaces for lectures and demos
- Teach basic horse care
- Demonstrate and teach horsemanship skills
- Act as a role model to all children attending camp
- Ability to direct and work with volunteers
